
In July 2018, TBB announced that our corporate partner - Detroit, has made their engines available in our C2 and HDX buses. Since then, Detroit DD5 became standard on Saf-T-Liner C2 and Detroit DD8 an option for HDX.

At that time, we provided information about Base and Extended Warranty options, new specification requirements for Axle Ratios as well as the introduction of Virtual Technician – the remote diagnostic service for buses equipped with Detroit engines.
